Scholarships

- ▶ The Class of 2019 was offered over \$33,000,000 in scholarships.
- ▶ Please turn in any scholarship offers you receive to Mrs. Harrell in the counseling office, even if you don't plan on attending the college/university that offers you the scholarship! Also, if you plan on enlisting in the military, please see Mrs. Huizenga in AC119.
- ▶ The deadline to submit scholarship offers/enlistment papers to be included in Royal Awards is April 3, 2020 at 4:30pm. **No exceptions due to the print deadline!**

Cap and Gown

- ▶ Cap, gown, tassel, and stole are the four pieces required for the graduation ceremony.
- ▶ Please order your cap and gown before December 13, 2019.
- ▶ The price will increase \$10, plus shipping, on December 13, 2019.
- ▶ Orders can be placed at www.Jostens.com or by calling 1-800-Jostens.
- ▶ Orders will be delivered to students during all lunches on Tuesday, March 3, 2020.
- ▶ If you are borrowing a cap/gown or using a sibling/friend's, you must have the BN stole and the '20 tassel for the cap.

Graduation Cords

- ▶ A letter and order form will be mailed in December with information about graduation cords.
- ▶ Each cord will be \$10. Exact cash, check, credit or debit cards are accepted. Order forms, with signatures, and payment must be submitted to Mrs. Miller in the front office.
- ▶ Deadline to order cords will be February 12, 2020.
- ▶ If your student qualifies as a AP Scholar, AP Scholar with Honor, or AP Scholar with Distinction, they must order and pay for their cord. If they do not order their cord, they will not receive the cord at Royal Awards. Their name will only appear in the Royal Awards program.
- ▶ The following cords are provided to seniors at no charge: Perfect Attendance, Military (students who have completed the enlistment process), and the Top Ten students **(not 10%)** in the class of 2019.

Graduation Ceremony

- ▶ There will be a letter sent to all seniors in March, with all of the details concerning graduation.
- ▶ Please make sure that we have your most current address, so that you receive this information. If your address has changed, please see the registrars to update your information.

Fines/Fees

- ▶ All fines/fees must be paid in order to purchase prom tickets.
- ▶ All district issued Chromebooks, textbooks, athletic equipment/clothing, must be returned or the fine for the items paid in full.
- ▶ Technology fines must be paid in full.
- ▶ Students will be able to participate in the graduation ceremony; however, diplomas will be held until all fines/fees are paid, or any district issued items is returned to campus.

Rank

- ▶ Rank will be run at the end of the first semester (January 2020).
- ▶ At the end of the 3rd quarter, rank will be run again to determine the Valedictorian, Salutatorian, and the Top 10%.

Diplomas

- ▶ Your legal name will appear on your diploma, which is the name that is on your birth certificate.
- ▶ If you anticipate your name changing, you must submit legal documentation to the registrars prior to January 31, 2020.
- ▶ If you do not participate in the graduation ceremony, your diploma will be available to pick up at BNHS, beginning on Wednesday, May 27, 2020 at 8:30 am.
- ▶ You will verify the spelling of your name for your diploma, and sign off on the signature page.
