
JOSTENS GRADUATION GARMENTS PICK UP IN STUDENT UNION 3/3

***Northwest ISD Education Foundation Scholarships** – The application is open to all eligible seniors in the Northwest ISD who enroll in an accredited college/university, military academies or trade school in the summer or fall of 2020. ***Denton County A&M Club** scholarship applications for graduating seniors in the Class of 2020 who have been accepted to A&M for the Fall of 2020. 2019-20 BNHS PROTOCOL ON DROPPING OFF STUDENT ITEMS/LUNCHES

A window of time for parents to drop-off items/lunches has been established a part of our safety and security procedures. From 11 - 11:45 AM, Monday through Friday, any lunch or other item that needs to be dropped off for students must occur during this window of time. A security officer is

outside or near the front office door to accept lunches or other items that students may need during the day. The security officer may examine the contents of the items as well. We will only accept the drop off of items & lunches between 11 – 11:45 AM. **Students –Pick up your items between passing periods or during your assigned lunch period.**

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

REQUEST A VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT FOR YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE

Students, if you need a verification of enrollment (VOE) for the Department of Motor Vehicles to get your permit or driver's license, please stop by your assistant principal's office to request one from your assistant principal's secretary. Principals' offices are located in AC119, AC221, & AC324. If you have already picked up your signed & dated VOE, remember the forms are only valid for 30 days.
