

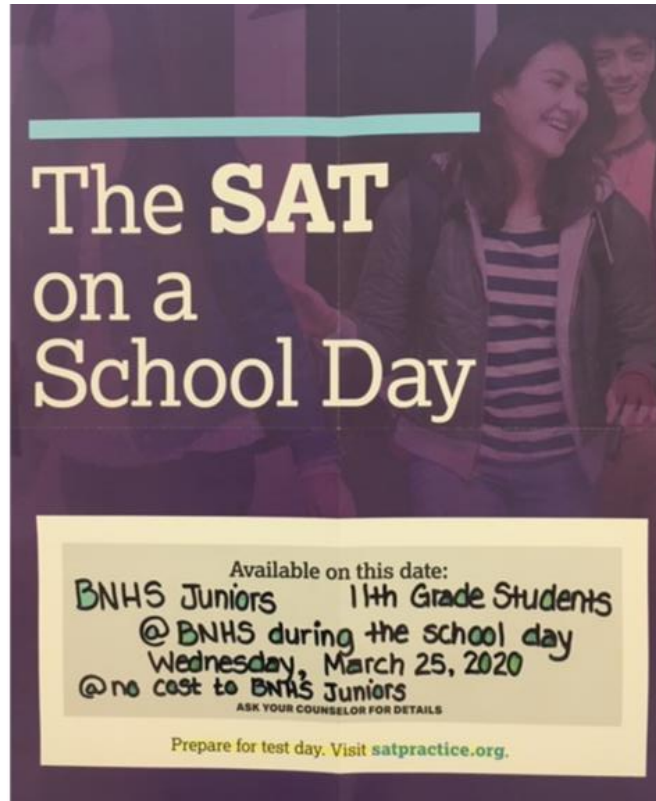

**\*Tri-County Electric Cooperative - Must be a current senior in high school. Reside in a home powered by Tri-County Electric. Email, hand deliver, or postmarked in mail the completed scholarship packet by 5 PM today, 3/6/2020.**

**\*The Metroport Rotary Club Scholarship** is open to a graduating senior in the class of 2020. This scholarship is based on academic achievement, financial need, extra curricular activities, and community service. Extra points are available for students who have participated in Rotary related activities. **Completed application packets are due no later than 3/15/2020.**

**\*Gerald Kendrick Memorial Scholarship** including application, transcript, and essay are due by email or postal mail by **3/17/2020**. The email and postal address are listed on the application.

**\*The Bernice Griffin Memorial Scholarship** is awarded to a Denton County high school graduate that feels he/she has overcome an obstacle, be it physical, emotional, or spiritual. **\*Denton County A&M Club** scholarship applications for graduating seniors in the Class of 2020 who have been accepted to A&M for the Fall of 2020. This application is entirely online; more information is located on the BNHS Counseling webpage. **Deadline for applications is Saturday, 3/21/2020.**

## **BNHS PROTOCOL ON DROPPING OFF STUDENT ITEMS/LUNCHES**

A window of time for parents to drop-off items/lunches has been established a part of our safety and security procedures. From 11 - 11:45 AM, Monday through Friday, any lunch or other item that needs to be dropped off for students must occur during this window of time. A security officer is

outside or near the front office door to accept lunches or other items that students may need during the day. The security officer may examine the contents of the items as well. We will only accept the drop off of items & lunches between 11 – 11:45 AM. **Students –Pick up your items between passing periods or during your assigned lunch period.**
