Dear Bobcat Families,

Open communication between home and school is important to Bobcat Nation. The mutual correspondence and dialogue helps all of our stakeholders gain a better understanding of the issues that our young people face. Currently, the main concern at the forefront for all of us is how to effectively deal with COVID. While I prefer to send good news about Bobcat Nation, it is also important that you remain informed.

Yesterday you received three Tier I Letters of confirmed COVID cases at BNHS. Although it is beyond our control as to who, where and when a COVID diagnosis is positive, it is necessary that we inform our families when a case is verified. With that in mind, our campus appreciates the ways in which our families have reported confirmed cases that have occurred outside the school setting. The communication also allows us to initiate further contact tracing and helps us to quarantine others, if necessary. Please keep in mind that wearing a mask and practicing social distancing as much as possible will help minimize the spread of COVID, and it will also minimize the likelihood that your student will be considered a close contact and be required to quarantine.

As we take steps at the campus level to create one way stairwells, add additional seating at lunch, remind students to walk on one side of the hallways, practice standing at safe distances when in lines and to wear masks, the communication that occurs at home supports our efforts as well. And, while I regret that these kinds of letters are sent, I trust that you know we are keeping you informed, as best we can.

Thank you for the support that you provide Bobcat Nation. We appreciate that you continue to trust us as we work together for all of our Bobcats.
