Yearbook Portraits Next Week!!

Byron Nelson students and guardians:

This year has given us the opportunity to change the way we have done some things in the past. Accordingly, to allow for social distancing and less gathering of students in an area, school ID photos and Yearbook portraits will be taken across four days, instead of one, by grade for grades 9-11 in the new wing's Rotunda. Portraits will still be taken during students' English classes.

We will begin with 9th grade on Monday, September 28, then 10th grade on Tuesday, September 29, and finally 11th grade on Wednesday, September 30. Thursday, October 1 will be designated as a make-up day for students who were absent and missed their class's portrait day. Their English teachers will allow them to go have that done during their class.

All underclassmen who are **REMOTE LEARNERS** will need to make plans to come up to the school **ANY** of those days (9.28-10.1) from **8:00-8:20 a.m.** to be photographed for school IDs and the Yearbook. Remote learners will need to drive to the rear of the building to the new wing and **enter through Entrance 38**, the blue Byron Bistro entrance. This is the closest entrance to the Rotunda, where the photographers will be set up, and it is the best way to avoid any other students and minimal staff while here to have that picture made.

Students do not need to pre-order or have any paper forms for underclass portraits. Glamourcraft, our photographer, will email proofs of your students' pictures and you can order online—contact free!
