TARDY PASSES ISSUED IN FRONT OFFICE, AC119, AC221, & AC324

Students, remember you need to be in your 1st period classroom at 8:40 AM. Throughout the day if you are late to class, you will be asked to go to the nearest office (AC119, AC221, AC324, or the front office) to pick up a tardy pass. Bring your student ID. Read your tardy pass to see if consequences have been issued. Each 9 weeks Tardy #1, 2, & 3: each a warning/no consequence. Tardy #4 & 5: each an Extended Classroom Opportunity (ECO). The date you are assigned ECO will be printed on your tardy paper. ECO is from 4:15 – 7:15 PM in AC118. Tardy #6 & 7: each a Saturday School from 8 AM - 12 noon; your tardy pass will show the date you've been assigned to serve it. Tardy #8 & each additional tardy is an In School Suspension (ISS). Tardy consequences reset each 9-week grading period.

REQUEST A VOE FOR YOUR PERMIT/DRIVER'S LICENSE

Students, if you need a Verification of Enrollment (VOE) for the Department of Public Safety to get your permit or driver's license, please stop by to request it from your assistant principal's secretary. AP offices are located in AC119, AC221, & AC324. VOE forms are valid for 30 days.

STUDENTS, KNOW WHERE YOU CAN PARK AT BNHS

Students should park their vehicles in numbered parking spaces. Please do not park in Staff, Handicap, Visitor, or Senior Parking (unless you have purchased that particular, Senior space). Senior with a reserved spot, if someone should park in your Reserved Senior Spot, please take down the BNHS permit number & license plate #, park in visitor, and see Mrs. Wilbur in the counseling office. She can help you get this resolved.
