TARDY PASSES ISSUED IN FRONT OFFICE, AC119, AC221, & AC324

Students, remember you need to be in your 1st period classroom at 8:40 AM. Throughout the day if you are late to class, you will be asked to go to the nearest office (AC119, AC221, AC324, or the front office) to pick up a tardy pass. Bring your student ID. Read your tardy pass to see if consequences have been issued.

- Tardy #1, 2, & 3: Each a warning/no consequence
- Tardy #4 & 5: Each an Extended Classroom Opportunity (ECO) 4:15 – 7:15 PM
- Tardy #6 & 7: Each a Saturday School from 8 AM - 12 noon
- Tardy #8 & each additional tardy is an In School Suspension (ISS)

If you are assigned an ECO, the date, time, & location you are assigned to serve it will be printed on your tardy paper. ECOs are Tuesday & Thursday from 4:15 – 7:15 PM in AC118. If you are assigned a Saturday School your tardy pass will show which Saturday you are assigned to serve it from 8 AM – 12 noon at BNHS. Tardy consequences reset each 9-week grading period.

PICK UP YOUR BNHS ID IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE

If you haven't picked up your 2020-21 student ID, please stop by the counseling office to claim yours.

LUNCH PERIOD STUDENT OPTIONS

Just a reminder that during lunches, all students are to remain in the Student Union, the original courtyard or the outside patio. Students are not permitted to eat lunch in the new courtyard. If you need to visit a teacher during your lunchtime, you must get a pass earlier in the day from the teacher to go the classroom during your lunch. Students are not allowed in the hallways without a pass.

STUDENTS, KNOW WHERE YOU CAN PARK AT BNHS

Students should park their vehicles in numbered parking spaces. Please do not park in Staff, Handicap, Visitor, or Senior Parking (unless you have purchased that particular, Senior space). Senior with a reserved spot, if someone should park in your Reserved Senior Spot, please take down the BNHS permit number & license plate #, park in visitor, and see Mrs. Wilbur in the BNHS counseling office. She can assist you.

BNHS PARKING PERMIT NEEDED FOR YOUR VEHICLE

We have begun ticketing automobiles that do not have a 2020-21 BNHS parking permit. Students, please see Mrs. Wilbur in the BNHS Counseling Office to purchase your permit.

REQUEST A VOE FOR YOUR PERMIT/DRIVER'S LICENSE

Students, if you need a Verification of Enrollment (VOE) for the Department of Public Safety to get your permit or driver's license, please stop by to request it from your assistant principal's secretary. AP offices are located in AC119, AC221, & AC324. VOE forms are valid for 30 days.

REGISTER TO VOTE; IT'S YOUR RIGHT & RESPONSIBILITY

Throughout the school year, if you are at least 17 & within 2 months of your 18th birthday OR 18+ years old, you can become a registered voter in the United States. Stop by AC119, the BNHS front office, or the counseling office to pick up a voter registration form. Complete the form in pen, seal it, & see Mrs. Huizenga in AC119 to place it in the outgoing U.S. Mail. You may register online at VOTETEXAS.GOV.

Do you want learn about military enlistment opportunities? During this time of social distancing we will not have recruiters visiting our campus.
