Phone Call Message to Parents/Guardians

Good afternoon, Bobcat Families,

As we continue to face challenges due to COVID, I want to send another reminder to our families about the importance of wearing masks and our process for notification, once a case is confirmed.

When students and families inform us of possible cases of exposures, our nurse and administrative team works to follow up on any reports by investigating each case. When those tests are confirmed, all families receive a Tier I Letter that informs the community. A Tier II Letter goes to those who may have been in contact and a Tier III Letter is more specific for the person involved.

With teens, I also realize that social gatherings are an important part of their lives. Whether it is attending a holiday party, birthday parties and/or just hanging out with friends, we need our students to wear their masks at those events as well. By doing so, and by following the procedures at school, (wearing masks at all times, sitting four to a table, walking on one side of the hallways, sanitizing desks) we expect those measures to help reduce illness and the need to quarantine.
