BE PREPARED FOR YOUR SCHOOL DAY & AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

BNHS DRESS CODE

Students, for safety & security reasons, please have your BNHS ID on your person & visible when you are on campus. Choose clothing to wear to school that follows the dress code guidelines in the NISD Student Code of Conduct. If you have questions about dress code issues, please see your AP.

TARDIES

Students, remember you need to be in your 1st period classroom at 8:40 AM. Throughout the day if you are late to class, you will be asked to go to the nearest office (AC119, AC221, AC324, or the front office) to pick up a tardy pass. Bring your student ID. Read your tardy pass to see if consequences have been issued.

- Tardy #1, 2, & 3: Each a warning/no consequence
- Tardy #4 & 5: Each an Extended Classroom Opportunity (ECO) 4:15 – 7:15 PM
- Tardy #6 & 7: Each a Saturday School from 8 AM - 12 noon
- Tardy #8 & each additional tardy is an In School Suspension (ISS)

If you are assigned an ECO, the date, time, & location you are assigned to serve it will be printed on your tardy paper. ECOs are Tuesday & Thursday from 4:15 – 7:15 PM in AC118. If you are assigned a Saturday School your tardy pass will show which Saturday you are assigned to serve it from 8 AM – 12 noon at BNHS. Tardy consequences reset each 9-week grading period.

LOG YOUR VOLUNTEER SERVICE HOUR in X2VOL

Remember to log your service hours in x2vol with the goal to earn your Green Cord. If you complete 100 or more community service hours May 1, 2020 – April 15, 2021 you are eligible to earn Green Cord distinction.

LUNCH PERIOD STUDENT OPTIONS

Just a reminder that during lunches, students are to remain in the Student Union, the original courtyard or the outside patio. Students are not permitted to eat lunch in the new courtyard or other areas of the building. If you need to visit a teacher during your lunchtime, you must get a pass earlier in the day from the teacher to go to the classroom during your lunch. Students are not allowed in the hallways without a pass.

STUDENTS, KNOW WHERE YOU CAN PARK AT BNHS

Students, if you drive to school & want to park a vehicle at BNHS during the school day, please see Mrs. Wilbur in the Counseling Office to purchase your vehicle permit. Students with a general parking permit are allowed to park a vehicle in a numbered parking space. Please do not park in Staff, Handicap, Visitor, or Senior Parking (unless you have purchased that particular, Senior space). Seniors with a reserved spot, if someone should park in your Reserved Senior parking space, please take down the BNHS permit number & license plate #, park in visitor, & see Mrs. Wilbur in the BNHS Counseling Office for assistance.
